The City of Paris and the Institut français, offer a **programme of residences** dedicated to **established writers and artists** in the fields of **visual and performing arts** who have already achieved international recognition.

Artists and writers who are selected by a consultative committee for a three months period residency, will benefit from a monthly grant of 1500 € and will be accommodated in one of the five residential studios of an average size of 50m².

THE RESIDENCE PROGRAMME
The purpose of the residence programme is to **host artists and writers who have a specific project to develop in Paris**. This project should preferably be carried out in partnership with a previously specified local institution or another structure, company, or artist, in Paris or the surrounding area for artists **in the fields of visual or performing arts, and for writers** as part of a research project. The project should be **developed in Paris**, in harmony with the host town and its cultural environment. This residence, which is a privileged period of reflection and creativity for the artist, will contribute to the presence and visibility of international artists in Paris.

LENGTH OF STAY
3 consecutive months without interruption and limited travels abroad. The residences will take place **from January to December 2013**.

TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIP SCHEME, SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND PROFESSIONAL STAYS

♦ **Teaching Assistantship scheme 2012/2013**
A selection committee took place in the *International Center for Pedagogical Studies* in Sèvres from May 2nd to 4th. It involved members of the *Department of Education and Skills*, of the *Cultural Service of the French Embassy* and of the *International Center for Pedagogical Studies*. At the close of the meeting, **67 Irish assistants** have been selected to go to **France for the 2012/2013 school year**, and **60 French assistants** have been selected to **come and assist the Irish French teachers** in their tasks. The assistantship program have continuously been a great success over the years, and is a key element in the Franco-Irish educational cooperation.

♦ **Summer Scholarship program**
26 Irish teachers of French have been selected as each year to go to France at CAVILAM school in Vichy, to participate in **professional training sessions**. Managed by the *Cultural Service*, the *Department of Education* and the *CNOUS*, the Summer Scholarship Program gives a unique opportunity to Irish teachers to gain valuable improvement in their **teaching skills**.

♦ **Professional Stays**
The Professional Stays are aimed either to language teachers or to teachers of non linguistic subject, wanting to be immersed in another teaching culture, and thus to discover new ways of teaching. **French teachers** can be hosted in this year, school and **Irish teachers** can spend two weeks in a French school, at any time of the school year. This year, 18 French teachers have been selected to come to Irish schools, and 2 Irish teachers will have the opportunity to spend two weeks in a French school.
